



ENROLLMENT POLICIES

Parents must express willingness for the applicant to be taught at Summit Christian Academy (SCA) according to the doctrinal statement of the school and are asked to sign a Family Statement of Cooperation annually. In addition, students in grades 5 through 9 are required to sign a Student Statement of Cooperation annually. Each student will be admitted on a yearly basis. Re-enrollment of a student will include an overall evaluation of continuing academic performance and conduct, and how the school will facilitate the student's educational development in light of that performance and conduct.

SCA's Biblical role is to work in conjunction with the home to mold students to be Christ-like. Of necessity, this involves the school understanding and belief of what qualities and characteristics exemplify a Christ-like life. The school reserves the right, within its sole discretion, to refuse admission of an applicant or to discontinue enrollment of a student if the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home or the activities of the student are counter to or are in opposition to the biblical lifestyle the school teaches. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, participating in, or condoning sexual immorality, homosexual or bisexual activity, promoting such practices, or being unable to support the moral principles of the school.

SCA reserves the right to refuse admittance or to dismiss any student or family that who does not respect in spiritual standards or cooperate in the educational endeavor. SCA admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. SCA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, athletic and/or other school-administered programs with respect to employment of faculty and administrative staff.
